IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS - READ CAREFULLY

To successfully complete the entire application process, you must follow **ALL OF THE STEPS** below, keep all appointments and meet all deadline dates. Failure to comply with **ALL OF THE STEPS** will disqualify your application.

An applicant must be at least 18 years of age.

STEP 1. Return the completed application with the following information.

- 1) A copy of your valid state issued I.D.
- 2) Motor Vehicle Report from the license bureau. (Must show any violations and points. No more than 4 points.)
- 3) A copy of your birth certificate.
- 4) A copy of your High School Diploma, GED Certificate with test scores, or proof pending graduation from high school.
- 5) Official grade transcript from your high school. **(Original)** In a sealed envelope unopened. Must have 2.0 GPA.
- 6) A copy of Military Transfer or Discharge Form DD-214, page 4, if applicable.
- 7) An application fee of \$ 30.00 (non-refundable) payable to the J.A.T.C. Money order or certified check only.
No cash or personal checks will be accepted.

STEP 2. An appointment to take an aptitude test.

- 1) When your completed application is reviewed, you will be given a scheduled date and time to take the test at Local 392 Training Center – 1300 Century Circle North – Cincinnati, OH 45246

STEP 3. An appointment for a personal interview with the Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee.

- 1) If you successfully meet the minimum required test score, you will be given a date and time for your personal interview with the J.A.T.C.

STEP 4. You will be required to successfully pass a drug and chemical-screening test to be eligible for employment.

- 1) Failure to successfully pass the drug and chemical-screening test will immediately terminate your application.

Failure to complete the above steps will disqualify your application

1. Must be at least 18 years of age.

IF YOU ARE ACCEPTED FOR A PROBATIONARY APPRENTICESHIP YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

1. Serve as a probationary apprentice for a period of 1 year (1700-2000 hours of on-the-job training);
2. Serve a 5 year apprenticeship including the probationary period (8500-10,000 hours of on-the-job training);
3. Report for work on a regular basis;
4. Provide for your transportation to and from the job site;
5. Work under the direction of a Journeyman on the job site and perform job duties satisfactory;
6. Attend related training classes regularly and maintain an acceptable average in those classes;
7. Purchase materials for use in related training classes as required;
8. Abide by all rules and regulations of the Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee;
9. Successfully pass a drug and chemical-screening test.

DUTIES OF AN APPRENTICE

Duties of an apprentice will require certain visual or audio skills to safely perform required tasks. *You must be able to see and hear sufficiently to perform these tasks; or be able to do so with or without accommodation.*

The apprenticeship duties require lifting a certain amount of weight, which may be up to a maximum weight of 50 pounds. These duties may occur anywhere from occasionally to regularly in the performance of apprentice duties. *You must be able to lift and /or handle these amounts of weights to perform the functions of an apprentice; or be able to do so with or without accommodations.*

Apprenticeship duties may require driving from place to place. Apprentices are expected to have a means of transportation (either personal or public) to get to any job site. MES apprentices must have a valid, current operator's license; not be under suspension; and, not be subject to restrictions that would prevent driving during working hours. *You must have a valid operator's license to perform the functions of an apprentice; or be able to do so with or without accommodations.*

Apprentices must have appropriate communication skills-that is, ability to or in other ways appropriate to the job at issue, communicate-with fellow apprentices, journeypersons, supervisors and others with whom they work and train. *You must be able to communicate effectively to perform the functions of an apprentice; or be able to do so with or without accommodations.*
